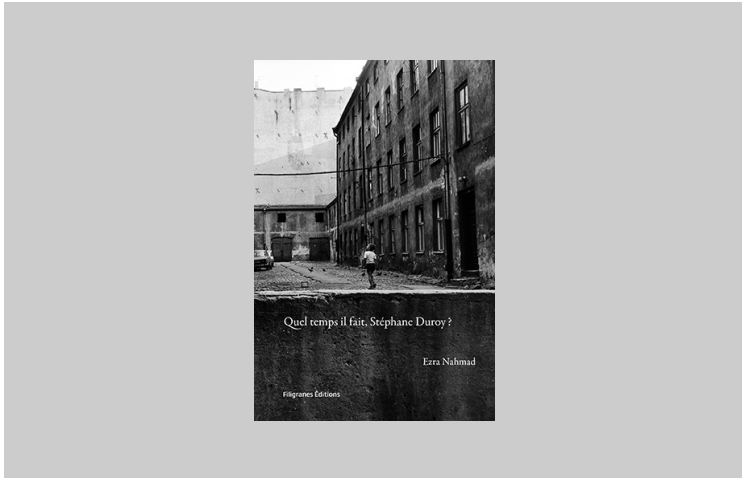


Quel temps il fait, Stéphane Duroy ?
