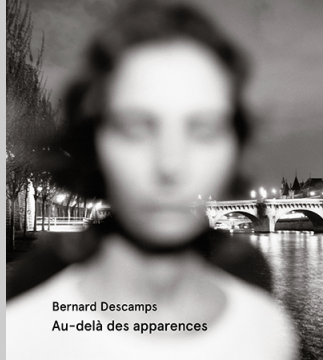


Au-delà des apparences

For fifty years, Bernard Descamps has explored photography in all its states, from the report to the landscape and the portrait, from black and white to color. A tireless traveler, Descamps went to many countries, meeting populations and their customs (Mali, India, Japan, China, Vietnam, Madagascar, Morocco, etc.).

However, he offers a travel photograph which is mainly that of the inner travel: its images, images, whose purity often approaches abstraction, "do not describe objects or events" but "would like to reveal tiny fragments time "in its own terms.
